CREATING A VENTILATION SYSTEM CHECK-UP FOR YOUR OPERATION

HERE ARE THREE STEPS OUR TEAM TAKES WHEN CHECKING A VENTILATION SYSTEM:

☐ Assessing the Controller

The first step in a ventilation audit is to check the controller to see how the ventilation stages are set up. From there, let the controller progress through the stages to ensure the fans are ramping up to get the correct air flow across the barn.

□ Checking Inlets

The next step is to make sure the inlets are accurate. This step also includes checking air let into the barn - so soffits, curtains, etc. It's important these all be free and clear and that there's no debris blocking the air flow.

■ Verifying Fan Performance

The final check would be to ensure that fans are running at the correct speed and they're performing as they should be.
